

This is to inform you that William G. Ricker of 23 Severeance Street in Claremont, New Hampshire has been accused of a lascivious act. Although his court case has been postponed until September, I have talked with enough people to be completely satisfied of his being guilty.

Ricker was Scoutmaster of Troop 318 in Claremont but was dismissed by the Troop Committee a few weeks before the above appeared in the newspaper. Their reason was stated as a personal situation at home. Ricker did make attempts to register with other Troops in this district but without success.

He is believed to be living in or near the Boston, Massachusetts area at the present time.
